## Combined Meeting of The Blueprint Executive Committee and Blueprint Planning and Evaluation Committee

Beth Tanzman opened the meeting at 8:30 a.m. and stated that today's meeting includes a presentation by Bi-State Primary Care Association and a discussion of the Blueprint modeling for Screening, Brief Intervention, and Navigation to Services (SBINS). She presented information describing the convergence of evidence-based practices for population health, such as Zero Suicide, SBIRT, and Accountable Communities for Health (ACH), and discussed additional opportunities such as health coaching.

Kate Simmons and Kristen Bigelow-Talbert gave a presentation on Social Determinants of Health screening in Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) and Rural Health Clinics. (See attached slides.)

Beth Tanzman presented slides and led a discussion about the potential to achieve systematic population screening, brief interventions, referrals, and help in navigating services. The Blueprint has modeled proposals to implement a system of SBINS. (See attached slides.)

Beth Tanzman also updated the participants on staffing changes. Jenney Samuelson, former Associate Director of the Blueprint, has taken a new position within DVHA as Special Assistant to the Commissioner.
