	Overview and Discussion	Julie Parker	<p><i>Julie Parker gives an overview of the last meeting session of the CHT Program Design Workgroup. This presentation is available under Action Items.</i></p> <p><i>Carey Yeaton of Lamoille Health Partners shares an overview of their screening questions given to pediatric patients, linked under Action Items. These questions were discussed between community partners to determine the most effective assessments, adjusted based on feedback from providers. Used as a CHT referral, with different aspects of the documents directing to other resources.</i></p> <p><i>Some areas of hesitations around workflow changes; who will be implementing/recording/taking action on these screenings. Solutions included putting these questions in a Portal ahead of time.</i></p> <p><i>From the patient point of view, how are these questions received? Giving a disclaimer and assurance of referrals upfront helps patients to feel more informed and helped.</i></p> <p><i>Ensuring pediatric screening questions going into the Child's file as opposed to the parents' file.</i></p> <p><i>Normalizing the connection between housing/food stability and health.</i></p> <p><i>Considering the difference in patient experience over paper screenings and in-person interview screening. Having an "anonymous" input leads to more positive responses, however the difference in results in approaches is not large.</i></p> <p><i>Finding supplemental questions in collaboration with the DULCE program's screening.
