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"How would screenings be used for patient referrals?"  - In the first year, we anticipate being able to understand how many unique patients were seen by CHT staff (which we assume results from patient needs being identified from screenings or other methods), with chart reviews and other methods, by year two we might have greater ability to understand in greater detail what types of care and referrals (to CHT and specialists) occurred as a result of screening.  "For the 250-patient threshold, are there attributes of those 8 or so practices that we can review to ensure those patients will still receive the care they need?"  - This will be considered and discussed further. The centralized resources will be reviewed and finalized for this solution.  Addressing a question from Rep. Houghton: Related to the ranges of attributed Medicaid members. We were able to follow up with DVHA on the specific percentages.  "For the Program Design Workgroup — What practices were screening information pulled from?"  - It was a pull from many Health Service Areas across the state, but not every one.
