ii	Expansion Updates: DULCE	Ilisa Stalberg	<i>There have been questions about DULCE in context of the Blueprint expansion. There are six grant-funded DULCE sites that will receive funding for the Family Specialist through the Blueprint Expansion Pilot Budget. All current DULCE sites will continue to offer the DULCE model, and the expansion pilot will provide additional CHT FTE (based on Medicaid attributions) at those 6 Sites.</i> <i>We have received a 4-year HRSA grant for development of early childhood programs, VDH plans to utilize that funding to support the expansion of DULCE into new sites.</i> <i>Care for maternal mental health will be handled at the discretion of the PCMH in accordance with NCQA requirements.</i>
