The following list of professionals can be considered acceptable staffing types eligible for hiring with expansion funds.

	Estimated Compensation
Licensed Mental Health Clinician, Social Worker, LADC, Family Specialist with License, Psychologist	\$74,250
Masters Level Clinician Family Specialist with Master	\$67,500
Community Health Worker	\$56,254

Practices may use expansion funding to:

- Add a new psychologist, clinical social worker, or counselor to a practice
- Add to existing CHT allocations at the practice to bring staffing levels up to the required Medicaid ratio floor
- Add Community Health Workers (CHWs) to the practice setting to address unmet social needs (have CHW perform this scope of work that was previously being done by clinical social worker, psychologist, or counselor)

At minimum, PCMHs with the following ratio of Medicaid Patients will have additional funding and be expected to have a psychologist, clinical social worker, community health worker or counselor(s) as a core member of the primary care team
