






Health of SASH Participants Statewide CY 2023

SASH Embedded Mental Health Pilot to Expansion



2017 collaboration between **One Care, Cathedral Square** and the **Howard Center**

The "SASH Clinician" began offering group programs and 1-1 services with a focus on promoting emotional health and wellness.

RESULTS

- Increased and expedited access to and utilization of mental health support.
- High level of participant satisfaction with services.
- Decreased Emergency Department visits.
- Stabilization/reduction in mental health symptoms.
- Reduction in the stigma associated with seeking mental health support.
- Support with housing retention, including prevention of evictions
